Sunday – Premier Standard, Master/Excellent Standard, Open Standard, Novice Standard, Premier Jumpers, Master/Excellent Jumpers, Open Jumpers, Novice Jumpers

First Received: Opening day of entry is June 9, 2026 at 8:00 a.m. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis. No hand delivered entries may be accepted for the first 24 hours the trial is open. Entries received opening day must include postage or be metered or be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including, but not limited to, USPS, FedEx, UPS, DHL. Any entries not meeting the above requirements must be returned. Entries received before the opening time and date must be returned to sender. All duplicate entries for the same dog will be declared ineligible and the entry fees forfeited. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Envelopes containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to sender. Overnight entries will NOT be accepted unless left WITHOUT signature required. On-line entries will not be accepted for this trial.

Awards: Placement ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class, provided that they have earned qualifying scores. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog earning a qualifying score. Rosettes and jump bars will also be awarded for MACH and PACH titles.

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs age of 15 months of age and over that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance

Height Divisions: Owners/agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. Dogs in the Preferred classes MUST jump in their measured height and may not jump in a higher height or any qualifying scores and placements earned will be disallowed.

Wait list for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time: Capital City Canine Agility Club is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 8 pm July 25, 2026. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6 pm Monday July 27, 2026 will be replaced by wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6 pm July 28, 2025 will receive a full refund.

Directions to Show Site

From Lansing: I-96 east to US -23 South to North Territorial Rd (exit 49). Follow the roundabout to East North Territorial (third exit). Exit Roundabout 1.1 miles to Hoban Way. Turn left 0.2 miles to show site.

From Toledo or Ann Arbor: US-23 North South to North Territorial Rd (exit 49). Follow the roundabout to East North Territorial (first exit). Exit Roundabout 1.1 miles to Hoban Way. Turn left 0.2 miles to show site.

From Detroit: I-96 east to M-14 east to Gotfredson Rd (exit 15). Turn right to North Territorial. Left on North Territorial approximately 8 miles to Hoban Way (turn right) just past Nollar Rd. before railroad tracks. 0.2 miles on Hoban Way to show site.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **Entry fees are \$23 per dog for first entry, \$20 for second, third, fourth entry of the same dog, same day**
- Telegraph, telephone, fax, and unsigned entries or entries without fees cannot be accepted.
- **Entries not on Official AKC Agility Entry without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry will NOT be accepted.**
- Express Mail Entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- Returned or post-dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for each returned check.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms correctly and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.
- Capital City Canine Agility Club (CCCAC) may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against CCCAC or any official thereof.
- CCCAC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of judge or show committee.
- Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial. Entry fee will be refunded for bitches in heat with a note from a veterinarian. Note must be received prior to the start of judging.
- **Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. CCCAC assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.**
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.
- **Please clean up after your dog.** Receptacles will be provided.
- Overpayments of fees less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons of other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (w) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may pt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Doges entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
